



· 2017 STUDY BY THE HONG KONG FEDERATION OF YOUTH GROUPS FOUND THAT 51% OF SECONDARY AND UNIVERSITY STUDENTS DISPLAYED SYMPTOMS OF DEPRESSION AND CLOSE TO 40% EXPERIENCED HIGH LEVELS OF STRESS.

• HKJC CENTRE FOR SUICIDE RESEARCH AND PREVENTION OBSERVED THAT SUICIDE RATES FOR FULL-TIME STUDENTS INCREASED BY 76% BETWEEN 2012 TO 2016.

Any frontline ministry staff will tell you that a conversation with a youth will show you how hungry they are for truth, a sense of belonging, and direction. It has become ever more palpable and evident since the political unrests of 2019 and the COVID pandemic, just how much they are looking for something real and stable to build their lives upon.

SECONDARY SCHOOLS


We reach out to all secondary students in relevant ways, wherever they are at in order to connect them to Christ.

YL UNIVERSITY

We support and guide the next generation shaping our city.

YOUNGLIVES

We work with vulnerable mothers age 25 and under from anywhere in the city, gathering in places suitable for playgroups and Clubs to encourage and support their early years of motherhood.



CONTACT WORK - CARING FOR KIDS

Within Young Life, we call the persistent going out into the world of kids, "contact work." But kids just call it friendship. We relentlessly go to where kids are to earn the right to be heard.

CLUB - A PARTY WITH A PURPOSE

We like to think of it as a party with a purpose. Before the party ends, we share the message about Jesus and His love for them because that's what the celebration is all about.

CAMP - THE BEST WEEK OF THEIR LIVES

A week where deep relationships are forged in the midst of mind-boggling fun, while also experiencing and listening to what we believe is the greatest love story ever told.

CAMPAIGNERS - QUESTION, LEARN AND GROW

Campaigners (a name that points back to the early days when Young Life was referred to as "The Young Life Campaign") is a weekly meeting for kids who wish to learn and grow in their faith through Bible study, service and leadership.

COMMITTEE - ADULTS WHO CARE

The community — comprised of parents, volunteers, teachers, and others who care about youth that provides a foundation of support.





MINISTRY HIGHLIGHTS

- **ZOOM CLUB** We were blessed to continue to meet new moms online despite strict COVID restrictions.
- **OUTDOOR EVENTS** We did a number of socially distanced activities like hikes, park time, and an Easter Egg hunt!
- **CAMP** We put together a hybrid virtual and in-person 3-day day camp at 3 locations. There was fun, laughter and tears as we shared the Gospel.
- **TRAINING** We continued to improve our service through training mentors, childcare, and alumni moms throughout the summer.




FINANCES AND BOARD




INCOME: HKD\$5.3M
