# THE NEED 的年 需輕

 51.5% of secondary school pupils now show symptoms of depression, and 25% demonstrate clinically-high levels of anxiety. Among university undergraduates, 69% currently show symptoms of depression, with 54% suffering from anxiety.

- Youth suicide rate (aged 10-19) more than doubled from 2014-2017, with 1 in 3 primary school students and 40% Form 1 students at risk of suicide.
  - Targeting at-risk youth is the most effective way to prevent mental health problems, as 75% of mental illnesses develop before the age of 24.

This fun-filled gathering aims to attract and welcome any youth. Before the party ends, we share a message about Jesus and His love for them, because that's what the celebration is all about.

## CAMPAIGNERS // Question, Learn, and Grow

Campaigners (a name that points back to when Young Life was referred to as "The Young Life Campaign") is a regular meeting for kids who wish to learn and grow in their faith through Bible study, service, and leadership.

## CAMP // The Best Week of Our Lives

A week where deep relationships are forged in the midst of mind-boggling fun, while also experiencing and listening to what we believe is the greatest love story ever told.

## COMMITTEE // Adults who Care

The committee — comprised of parents, volunteers, teachers, and others that care about youth — provides a foundation of support.

When Hana\* first came to Young Life, she had trouble expressing her emotions. She would suddenly burst into tears one moment and then become angry and curse in the next. Her family was going through a lot of issues, and Hana believed she was responsible for it all.

When Young Life hosted events at her school, Hana started to come and met the YL leaders. These leaders became a constant presence in her life. It was at these events that Hana began to experience a safe and stable environment and the love of Jesus for the first time. Gradually, she learned to express and manage her emotions. Even her parents pointed out that Hana was becoming more mature after hanging out with these Christian leaders.

Hana comes from a Sikh background and is now interested to *learn more about Jesus* and His love for her!

We're excited to continue to walk with him in this journey.






