WHAT IS YOUNG LIFE?

Our mission is to introduce young people to Jesus Christ and help them grow in their faith. We do this not by starting with a program, but with relationships: we pray for young people, go where they are, and build connections of authentic friendship with them.

Alongside our community of caring adults, we provide fun, adventurous, life-changing, and skill-building experiences for young people ages 12 to 24 from all over the city, earning the right to share the good news of Jesus Christ and inviting young people to personally respond.



In 2014, Young Life landed in Hong Kong, reaching out to young people in relevant ways that have been tested by greater Young Life for over 80 years in more than 100 countries worldwide.

THE NEED AND THE HOW

The years spent as an adolescent and then a young adult are formative, with significant changes and transitions. As young people develop, searching for direction and purpose amid the demands of their environment — including peers, family, academics, and extracurriculars — they also seek a community who can walk alongside, support, and guide them.

Every caring and present adult in a young person's life makes a positive impact.

CONTACT WORK

We befriend young people wherever they may be — such as at schools, cafes, and sports grounds — and walk with them in their daily lives.

CLUB

We throw "a party with a purpose" where everyone is invited. It's an open and fun space celebrating relationships, where young people hear real, life-changing stories about Jesus.

CAMP

Said to be "the best week of our lives," we invite young people to an adventurous time away, where deep relationships are formed through mind-boggling fun and intentional discussions about what we believe is the greatest love story ever told.

CAMPAIGNERS

Relationships are nurtured in small group settings, where leaders regularly meet with young people who want to learn and grow in their spiritual life through Bible study, service, and leadership.

COMMITTEE

Caring adults from all walks of life — such as teachers, parents, church leaders, and mentors — consistently gather to support young people through their prayer, resources, experience, and encouragement.

STORIES FROM THE FIELD

When 13-year-old Nate* first came to Young Life events, anger raged inside him. Sometimes it came out in flaring redness, other times in punches into walls, or even people. Friendship and the feeling of being cared for drew him into Young Life Club (or "that Jesus club" as students sometimes called it) at Concordia Lutheran School of North Point. Though he came, he kept his guard up, never answering anything beneath the surface level.

Over the next couple of years, God's love through the community melted his exterior. He was willing to share more openly. We learned he came from a difficult family background, including abuse and divorce. With peers, he frequently faced bullying. In 2023, he started coming regularly to Ascend, a citywide Club where students and leaders bouldered and heard real life stories of Jesus together. Leaders met his mom, who shared that Young Life gatherings were the only events Nate attended outside of school. He had often felt unsafe and unwelcomed by peers.

At the 2024 summer camp, he had a teary-eyed sharing during cabin time, and his leaders saw what a long way he had come from the angry, guarded person they had first met. This year he has committed to attending a church youth group and even invites his friends to come!



YOUNG LIFE UNIVERSITY

Han*, a second year higher diploma student, had already lost vision due to glaucoma in his left eye when we met him in 2023. Han called himself a Buddhist, and had many questions regarding worldviews and spirituality, especially the love of any supernatural being in the midst of uncertainty and personal pain, such as potential complete loss of sight.

As Han's vision worsened, Aaron visited him at the hospital three to four times a week, bringing along his two elementary-aged children who would share Bible stories. Aaron shared he knew of another way than doing good to create a better next life through karma. Han couldn't believe there was a better way! This led to reading the Bible together for the first time, after which he said, "I feel so much peace right now."

A month later, Han found out he would never see again and faced many dark thoughts, asking himself if life was worth living. After serious discussion and prayer, he decided the only place he could find true hope and joy was in God. He made a decision to follow God and has now been plugged into his local church and telling others of the Good News.

"My name is Elaine, my daughter is Serena and my son is Wang Yik (Jason): I was born in.

Hong Kong to Asian parents: I have two children; a 4-year-old daughter and a 1-year-old son.

I live with them and take care of them alone:

I came into contact with Young*Lives* when I participated in a Mother's Choice event after I gave birth to my daughter. I learned that Young*Lives* also serves young mothers and provides us with meaningful activities, such as playgroups, mom small groups, and seasonal parties. I joined Young*Lives* in October 2020.

At every Young Lives gathering, I encounter familiar faces. These mature and reliable volunteers always bless and encourage me, leaving me with a sense of warmth and safety. Also, being able to meet other young moms helps me no longer feel alone, and I now have friends who can care for and understand each other. Young Lives connects such kind hearts and gathers them together.

Often times, us young moms have been hurt, and we can relate to each other's experiences. I can safely share my weaknesses, which allows me to heal from unbearable and sad experiences, and in turn helps me to reflect and learn to accept myself. The circle of people I talk to at Young*Lives* has been a very important part of my personal growth. In Young*Lives*, both leaders and other mothers are friendly and willing to share their experiences, joys, and sorrows, teaching me a lot about how to treat others and respond to practical problems in my life.

Young Lives 把一班善良的人都連繫到一起,很多時我們都是受過傷,經歷的痛楚是相近的,我可以放心地分享自己弱點,讓我可以療癒過往不堪和難過的經歷,使我接受自己和反省過去。 Young Lives 這個傾訴的圈子,對我個人成長中是非常重要的部分,我更了解自己。 在Young Lives 裏無論在義工或其他媽媽,她們都很友善,願意分享經驗,也會分享喜悅和分擔 難過,也讓我學習到很多,待人接物和解決問題的方法。

There are many young mothers around the same age, and it is a constant challenge for all of us to love our children. We have to sacrifice a lot to protect our children, facing obstacle after obstacle with courage in order to do what's right for them. This helps me feel that I am not stupid, but I am willing to sacrifice myself to invest in my children. Whatever trial we are going through, we always receive affirmation and support from Young Lives volunteers, who offer their guidance and wisdom, relieve our doubts and stress, and give us the confidence to do our best in staying true with our original intentions."






FINANCIALS 2023-24*
